Hat Fair is Britain's longest running outdoor arts festival. Held annually at the beginning of July. The Hat Fair markets are an integral part of the festival, adding greatly to the atmosphere and level of enjoyment of the audiences. This year the festival will again run over two days in the City with stalls being placed in the Cathedral grounds, Broadway and Abbey Gardens. Due to a reduced scale of the festival the number of places is limited so do get your applications in early.

Anticipated Numbers – 500 to 1500 people This row is actually situated in the Cathedral Grounds with plenty of visitors, street performances and activity throughout the day.


The Broadway (SAT & SUN)

Anticipated Numbers – 500 to 1,000 people Attractive park in Central Winchester, often used by families for picnicking. Street performances will be scheduled here throughout Saturday.
